

Rose of Hanfield/Dragon tongue

There is an old tale about an evil wizard who once turned a young loving couple into a flower in Hanfield. That is why the Hanfield roses have two stems that turn into one beautiful rose. But anyone who disturbs the couple (the plant) must suffer the poison that kills in agony. The plant can only be found near Hanfield Castle. The flower is known to the elves as dragon tongue. The plant is extremely rare. It is only found in the large rose gardens of Hanfield, where a few of them are found amidst thousands of ordinary red roses.

When inhaled, the scent of this plant offers fortitude save DC 13. Initial: paralysed for 1d4 minutes, secondary: None.

The thorns and juice of the plant offer fortitude save DC 26. If ingested or injury an initial damage: 2d12 hp, secondary damage is 3d6 Con.

The flower of the plant however, acts as a *cure for light wounds*, if placed on wounds. If the flowers are boiled in hot water, the tea can be used to *remove disease*.
